### Present

<b>I</b>	dump
<b>you</b>	dump
<b>he/she/it</b>	dumps
<b>we</b>	dump
<b>you</b>	dump
<b>they</b>	dump

### Present continuous

<b>I</b>	am dumping
<b>you</b>	are dumping
<b>he/she/it</b>	is dumping
<b>we</b>	are dumping
<b>you</b>	are dumping
<b>they</b>	are dumping

### Simple past

<b>I</b>	dumped
<b>you</b>	dumped
<b>he/she/it</b>	dumped
<b>we</b>	dumped
<b>you</b>	dumped
<b>they</b>	dumped

### Past continuous

<b>I</b>	was dumping
<b>you</b>	were dumping
<b>he/she/it</b>	was dumping
<b>we</b>	were dumping
<b>you</b>	were dumping
<b>they</b>	were dumping

### Present perfect

<b>I</b>	have dumped
<b>you</b>	have dumped
<b>he/she/it</b>	has dumped
<b>we</b>	have dumped

### Present perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	have been dumping
<b>you</b>	have been dumping
<b>he/she/it</b>	has been dumping
<b>we</b>	have been dumping
<b>you</b>	have been dumping

### Past perfect

<b>I</b>	had dumped
<b>you</b>	had dumped
<b>he/she/it</b>	had dumped
<b>we</b>	had dumped

### Past perfect continuous

<b>you</b>	dump
