<b>I</b>	irk
<b>you</b>	irk
<b>he/she/it</b>	irks
<b>we</b>	irk

<b>they</b>	irk

### Present continuous

<b>I</b>	am irking
<b>you</b>	are irking
<b>he/she/it</b>	is irking
<b>we</b>	are irking
<b>you</b>	are irking
<b>they</b>	are irking

### Simple past

<b>I</b>	irked
<b>you</b>	irked
<b>he/she/it</b>	irked
<b>we</b>	irked
<b>you</b>	irked
<b>they</b>	irked

### Past continuous

<b>I</b>	was irking
<b>you</b>	were irking
<b>he/she/it</b>	was irking
<b>we</b>	were irking
<b>you</b>	were irking
<b>they</b>	were irking

### Present perfect

### Past perfect
